Example from Chapter 1: I. General Heading: The Automobile

Sub-title: Electrical System; Consists of several smaller circuits designed to perform specific functions

- 1. **Ignition System**; Produces extremely high voltage surges across the spark plug to burn the air fuel mixture in the combustion chamber
- 2. Starting System; The battery and started motor crank the engine until it can run on its own
- 3. Charging System; Replaces the electrical energy drawn from the battery when starting the engine
- 4. **Lighting System**; Components that operate the vehicle's exterior and interior lights (bulbs)
